The research activity is related to the ongoing project "A priori estimates for elliptic operators and applications" - Research Grants - Young Investigators Grants - Phase II - 18/15484-7 with the goal of studying general properties (a priori estimates, solvability and regularity) associated to elliptic and canceling linear differential operators and related problems.
